- 1. To know the technical parameters, control procedures, and control and protection devices of tower cranes; the structure, and main units and electrical devices of cranes; the structure and operation of mechanics, and the table of crane lubrication:
- 2. To know the requirements for installation of crane rails and their maintenance, and rules for work performance with cranes:
- 3. To understand possible technical problems of cranes, their causes and elimination methods, and the main causes of accidents when working with tower cranes;
- 4. To know the manufacturer's operational manual of the crane in operation, the technical maintenance and repair systems of cranes, and health and safety instructions for operators of tower cranes;
- 4. To control tower cranes, and carry out cargo lifting and construction erection works;
- 5. To perform crane maintenance works, regulate brakes and eliminate simple defects;
- 6. To use cargo slinging schemes, projects for work with cranes; read drawings and schemes provided in the crane operational manual;
- 7. To use signalling methods for cargo lifting works;
- 8. To follow the requirements of health and safety at work, and fire protection, electrical safety and environmental protection.

4. Range of occupations accessible to the holder of the certificate¹

Working with tower cranes at construction sites, and warehouses reloading cargos using various methods; performing cargo transfer, transportation, and warehousing works, and technical maintenance of tower cranes.
