Profile of skills and competences

To control overhead cranes;

To know technical characteristics of the cranes in operation;

- To assess the level of risk, and take preventive actions in order to avoid accidents;
- To determine causes of simple defects and eliminate them;

To check the technical condition of a crane;

- To prepare a crane for technical inspection;
- To perform technical maintenance of overhead cranes;

To adjust crane brakes and safety devices;

To assess the degree of rope wear;

- To know signalling and the requirements for cargo slinging;
- To fill-in crane operation documentation;
- To render first aid to an injured party.

Working as an operator of overhead cranes at industrial companies, warehouses, and construction sites that use overhead cranes.
