- 5 Know traffic rules, and specific traffic rules for the territory of a company.
- 6. Know methods for lifting and lowering loads.
- 7. Identify minor breakdowns of an electric fork lift.
- 8. Replace load picking and loading devices.
- 9. Perform maintenance of forklifts on each shift.
- 10. Transport hazardous loads with a forklift.
- 11. Know the key characteristics of hazardous loads and methods of storage.
- 12. Render first aid to injured parties.

The holder may manage electric forklifts and stackers and perform transportation and reloading operations in warehouses; transport and reload cargo, and unload cargo from ship's holds, trucks, etc
