2. Know how to draw diagrams used in steel structures; understand markings, and presentation and markings of welding seams in the drawings.

3. Read descriptions of welding procedures.

4. Select welding modes and adjust them during the welding process.

5. Select electrodes for particular work according to markings.

6. Perform visual assessment of welding seams.

7. Perform measurements and assess possible alteration of measurements during welding.

8. Know defects of welding seams, identify their causes, and eliminate them.

9. Use personal protective equipment.

10. Render first aid to injured parties.
