## 3. Profile of skills and competences

Competences of qualification:

- 1. Know the organization of the ship's service, the structure and equipment of the ship.
- 2. Survive at sea after the ship has been abandoned.
- 3. Make assessment and reduce the risk of fires.
- 4. Participate in fire-fighting operations and eliminate the fire consequences.
- 5. Take appropriate action in the event of emergencies and accidents.
- 6. Apply precautions and contribute to the prevention of pollution of the marine environment.
- 7. Eliminate ship emergency consequences.
- 8. Apply occupational health and safety precautions and comply with the ship safety plan.
- 9. Contribute to the effective communication on board.
- 10. Contribute to the effective relationships aboard ship.
- 11. Evaluate fatigue and take appropriate action to control it.
- 12. Keep watch in the engine room.
- 13. Maintain a suitable water level and proper steam pressure for the boiler.
- 14. Suitable emergency equipment and emergency procedures.
- 15. Supervise internal combustion engines.
- 16. Supervise auxiliary mechanisms.
- 17. Supervise ship systems.
- 18. Adopt and pump fuel and lubricants.
- 19. Know the types of alarms, alarm bills and cabin lists.
- 20. Be able to prepare and use measures to combat the viability of the ship.
- 21. Be able to locate and prime the water permeability.
- 22. Extinguish and liquidate fires.
- 23. Be able to use all the available on-board survival equipment.
- 24. Be able to provide first aid.
- 25. Understand and avoid potential hazards on board.
- 26. Follow the ship security plan.

The object of the activity of the motorman:

Work of the International Labour Organisation under the MARPOL Convention. Thus, persons who have completed the qualification of the ship's electrician will be able to work in Lithuanian and foreign ships on international voyages.
