Know types and characteristics of solid, liquid, and gas fuel and the burning process. 3. Prepare solid fuel for burning. 4. Read technological schemes of serviced steam and water boilers. 5. Know the construction of steam and water pipe systems. 6. Monitor and regulate the parameters, pressure, and temperature in the boiler. 7. Prepare boilers for switching on, and switch off boilers. 8. Switch on/off and maintain auxiliary equipment during the operation of the boiler. 9. Prepare and perform inspection and hydraulic testing of boilers. 10. Maintain an economical burning process and regulate the intensity of burning. 11. Remove cinder and ashes. 12. Render first aid to injured parties.
