5. Know the requirements for marking certain electrical equipment in the main types of schemes; 6. Know the technologies for the repair and installation of lifts;

7. Prepare lifts for complete and partial technical inspections, prepare lifts for testing, and approve lifts for use;

8. Check the operation of the control and safety devices of lifts;

9. Identify defects in certain lift systems and perform repair work on those systems;

10. Inspect lift cables for defects and replace them when necessary;

11. Provide the first aid to the injured.
