- 1. Assess peculiarities and causes for the development of a bee colony.
- 2. Perform spring maintenance of beehives.
- 3. Expand and look after each colony.
- 4. Assess the strength of each colony.
- 5. Assess and improve fields for nectar and pollen.
- 6. Harvest honeycombs and prepare the beehive for winter.
- 7. Grow queen bees and raise bee colonies.
- 8. Divide bee colonies.
- 9. Identify diseased bees and bee cells and apply efficient disease prevention and treatment methods.
- 10. Select races (lines) of bees according to the available types of fields.
- 11. Observe safety requirements.
- 12. Select the type of beehive according to the type of bees available.
- 13. Select inventory required for an apiary.
- 14. Collect products from beehives.
- 15. Render first aid for bee stings to people and animals.
